## **MARIANNA BABY BONNET**

This pattern has been designed by Lyn Bennett Wilson and compiled by pattern designer [wendyg-designs.com](http://wendyg-designs.com) To fit a baby 3 to 6 months old.

### **PHOTOS HAVE BEEN ADDED AT END OF PATTERN**

### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

Approx 53 grams #4 worsted weight yarn (10ply)

A pair of 4.5mm (7) needles.

1 meter of ribbon for tying.

Embellishments as required.

Yarn needle for sewing up seam.

### **BONNET**

Cast on 63 stitches.

1st Row: Knit

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

5th Row: (picot row) K1, \*yarn forward, knit 2 together, Repeat from \* to end of row.

6th Row: Purl.

7th Row: Knit.

8th Row: Purl.

### **JOIN PICOT**

With right side facing fold bottom of work up to sit behind the stitches that are on the needle, then knit together 1 stitch from needle with corresponding stitch from cast on edge all the way across row. I have linked a video in here for you to watch if you're not sure how to do this

Next row: Knit decreasing 1 stitch in middle of row (62 stitches)

### **Now commence the feather and fan pattern.**

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Knit 3 stitches, purl to last 3 stitches knit 3 stitches (The 3 stitches each end form the garter stitch border)

3rd Row: Knit 4 stitches, \*(knit 2 together) 3 times, (knit 1 yarn forward) 6 times, (knit 2 together) 3 times\* Rep from \* to \* until 4 stitches are left, knit 4 stitches.

4th Row: Knit.

These 4 rows form the pattern, repeat them a further 7 times, increasing 1 stitch on the last row. (63 stitches)

**Work 2nd picot as follows.**

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: knit.

4th Row: Purl.

5th Row: (picot row) K1, \*yarn forward k2 together, Repeat from \* to end of row.

6th Row: Purl.

7th Row: Knit.

8th Row: Purl.

**JOIN PICOT**

with right side facing knit 1 stitch from needle with corresponding stitch from row 1 of picot, being careful not to pick up from the row where the hole were made on the last feather and fan pattern.

Next Row: Knit decreasing 3 stitches across this row. (60 stitches)

**SHAPE CROWN**

1st Row: \*knit 8 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

2nd and every alt row: knit.

3rd Row: \*knit 7 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

5th Row: \*knit 6 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

7th Row: \*knit 5 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

9th Row: \*knit 4 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

11th Row: \*knit 3 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

13th Row: \*knit 2 stitches, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

15th Row: \*knit 1 stitch, knit 2 together, rep \* to end.

17th Row: \*knit 2 together, rep \* to end. (6 stitches)

Break yarn leaving a long end and thread through the 6 stitches, pull up tight, then using yarn sew the back seam to the picot row.

**NECK BAND**

With right side of work facing beginning at the first ridge of Garter stitch border pick up and knit 24 stitches along the side to the crown seam, then pick up 1 stitch from crown seam and 24 stitches along other side to the last ridge of the garter stitch border (49 stitches).

This picture may explain it better.



**Continue as follows.**

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Knit 1 stitch, \*yarn forward, knit 2 together, Repeat from \* to end of row.

3rd Row. Knit.

Bind off.

Sew in all ends. Thread Ribbon throw holes in neck band.



FREE PATTERN
